Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you and your families have found an opportunity to find rest over the summer break. A very warm welcome to you all and especially any new families joining us this September. We look forward to welcoming our students back at **8:25am on Tuesday 4th September**. Site staff have been working hard over summer and there have been many enhancements made to our school building to improve our facilities and there are also some new initiatives starting in September.

Firstly, may we remind you that our new school day begins at 8:25am and features five one hour lessons with the school day finishing at 2:45pm. Secondly our exciting bucket list opportunities, Period 6 booster and catch-up sessions will run from 2:45pm until 3:45pm. These will commence on Monday 10th September. Students will be shown the timetable on Wednesday 5th September and students will be told how to sign up for their activities.

Finally, may we take this opportunity to remind parents and carers about the importance of wearing full school uniform. It is worth noting that once again, we have tried to take a 'reasonable approach' to uniform this year in the hope that parents will find it easier to support us in insisting that all students comply. We are defining a black shoe as something that black polish can be applied to, does not have any coloured or white logos, does not have any canvas on it and does not cover the ankle bone. A small black logo on the heel or sole of the shoe is acceptable. I hope that this will help make it easier to find footwear that is comfortable, affordable and smart.
