

Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you for your support in returning our students to school in excellent uniform. I ask that any outstanding issues are addressed as quickly as possible to ensure all are in full uniform including a blazer. I would also issue a plea that you remind your child to bring a face mask to school every day as these are mandatory in communal areas.

Our students continue to be a source of pride in how quickly they adapt to changes in circumstances. Despite the challenges of a new daily routine in school we are seeing them back in class learning which is exactly where we want them to be.

I am pleased to inform you it is our intention to invite all students to a Leavers Prom on the 30th June should the current restrictions be lifted and all safety measurements be in place to allow us to do so. I hope you understand we will only be able to hold a Prom should restrictions be lifted so please be mindful of this when considering making any purchases.

Currently every student at St Joseph's is invited to attend the Prom however their invitation will be withdrawn for not meeting expected standards. The criteria have been explained to your child and are as follows;

- i) being excluded from school
- ii) being placed in internal exclusion (inclusion) on more than one occasion
- iii) attendance of less than 96%
- iv) consistently failing to meet the St Joseph's standard

Other circumstances in which an invitation is withdrawn will be at the discretion of members of the Senior Leadership Team. Should there be extraordinary circumstances e.g. medical conditions which mean a child has not met the criteria which need to be considered we will take these into account.
