

Subject	Year 9
Art	Pupils will be focusing on photography and observational drawings linked to Architecture. They will use a range of drawing, mixed media and Art apps on their phone.
ASDAN	Continuing with challenges in the COPE booklet as before lockdown.
BTEC H&S Care	Pupils are continuing to follow the SOL covering Unit 1a. This unit covers a wide range of factors which affect growth and development e.g. lifestyle choices: smoking, drugs, alcohol, diet and role models. They will form an understanding of how the choices that we make or situations that we find ourselves in can positively or negatively affect health and well-being.
Creative iMedia	Creative iMedia - R081 pre-production skills theory.
D&T Food	Pupils will continue to work through the theory element of the usual unit of work – Diet and Good Health. Pupils will undertake a wide variety of tasks which have been adapted to suit home learning. Topics include special diets: diet related illness, vegetarian diets, religion and diet and food allergy and intolerance. There will be practical lessons set where necessary – though these will be very limited and subject to parental permission and supervision. Once this unit has been completed, pupils will progress to Unit 3: Fruit & Vegetables.
D&T RM	Pupils will be working on developing skills in CAD modelling, this is an important tool in both developing and presenting ideas but also in manufacture as the files created can be used in the manufacturing process. Pupils will look at the advantages and disadvantages of CAD and CAM and build their understanding of them both.
D&T Textiles	Pupils will continue to follow the current SOW, as closely as possible. They will continue to develop their theoretical knowledge, whilst beginning a new project at home. The new project begins with research, task analysis and design ideas. The pupils will also be taught various textile techniques, where they must understand the method so it can be applied in the classroom.
Drama	Skill development. To be able to complete the 4, 8, 12 mark question to a high standard. To develop understanding of Drama theory and how to apply the skills to both written and practical work. To be able to use a personal skill audit to highlight personal development.
English	Power and Conflict Poetry - Conflict cluster.
Geography	Weather Hazards, focusing on tropical storm formation and effects.
History	Medicine through time, medicine from 1900.
IT	Business - Putting business ideas in to practice.
Maths	Yr 9 Foundation - Exploring data through tables, charts and graphs. Yr 9 Higher - Sequences. Averages and Range. Interpreting data through charts and graphs.
Music	To develop my appraisal skill and knowledge of elements of music through practice GCSE listening questions. To revise the set work studies 'Africa' and 'Since you been gone'. To develop recognition of intervals and knowledge of music notation. To continue with solo performance practice on your chosen instrument.
PE	Ro45 - Lo1 - Diet and nutrition looking at key components of a healthy diet - looking in detail all the characteristics of a balanced diet. Comprehensively describing what nutrients are and their role within a healthy balanced diet, looking and giving a wide range of examples of food source nutrients.
RE	Social and Medical Ethics: IVF; Transplant Surgery; Genetic Engineering; Law and Justice; Theories of Punishment; and Capital Punishment.
Science	Biology - photosynthesis and respiration. Chemistry - atmosphere and chemical analysis. Physics - particle model of matter. PLUS skills work.
Spanish	Completing work on restaurant; discussing meals and special occasions; cultural awareness, hispanic eating habits, Technology in Everyday Life.
