Definitions

- **Passport** – A pass to allow people or animals to travel
- **Portable** – Can be carried easily
- **Transport** – To carry people or goods from one place to another
- **Porter** – Carries bags for customers
- **Support** – Carries or holds up
- **Portly** – Someone who is carrying a bit of weight

Define it:

Port = Latin for **carry**

Porter - 'Carries' luggage or other people's belongings

Keith does not enjoy being a porter and finds some customers rude

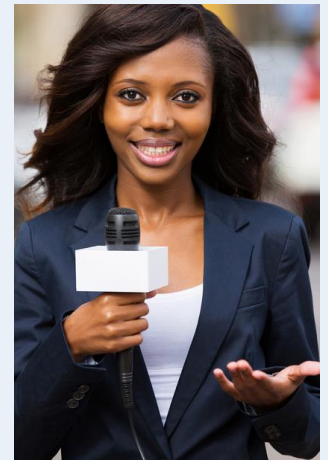


Export - 'carry' out
