

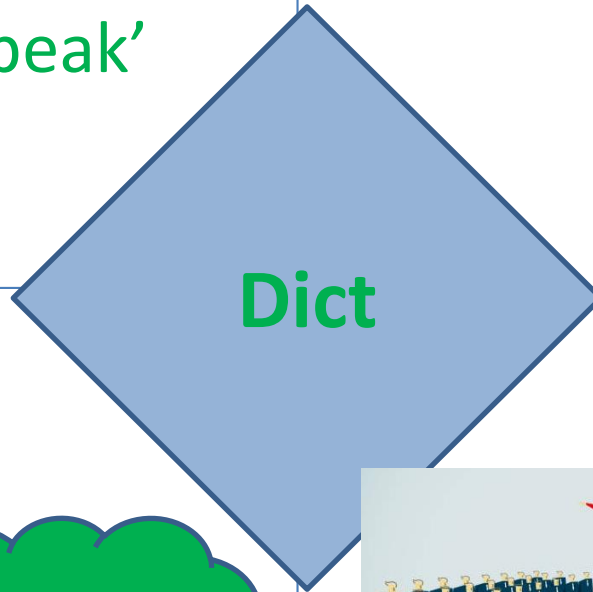

Definitions

- **Diction** – The manner in which words are pronounced
- **Verdict** - a decision that a jury say as to whether someone is guilty after having heard the facts given at a trial.
- **Dictator** -a person who gives orders and behaves as if they have complete power.

Define it:

Dict = Latin for **I say/speak**

Dictionary - a book that contains a list of words in alphabetical order and explains their meanings
