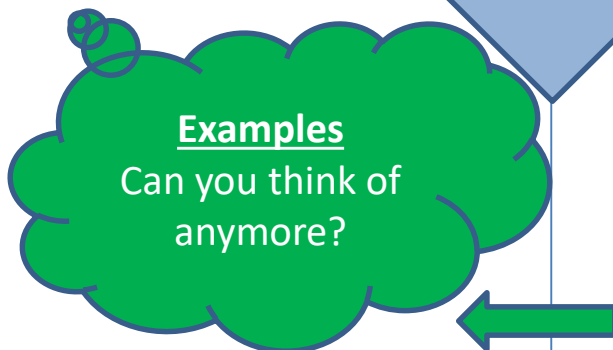

Definitions

Astrology – the study of the movement of suns, planets, moons and stars which are interpreted as having an influence on human affairs and the natural world.

Asteroid – a small or large rock which orbits the sun.
