
Root of the Week

Definitions

Metrology – The science of weights and measures.

Thermometer – A device for measuring temperature.

Hydrometer – An instrument used for measuring the speed or discharge of water in rivers, from reservoirs.

We have looked at this root previously. Can you remember what it means?

Define it:

Metre = Greek for 'measure'
