Definitions

Ambidextrous – Being able to use both hands equally

Ambiguous – Having more than one meaning.

Ambitious – having or showing a strong desire and determination to succeed regardless of the difficulties.

Define it:

Ambi = Latin for 'Two opposing ideas'

Ambidextrous - My friend can write just as neatly with her left hand as she can with her right because she is **ambidextrous**.

Ambiguous - The wording of the holiday agreement is **ambiguous**.
