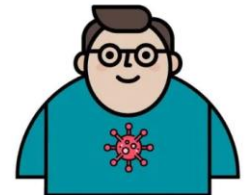

Definitions

Amoral- To lack a moral sense; unconcerned with what is right or wrong

Acellular- NOT consisting of, divided into, or containing cells

Abyss - a deep or seemingly bottomless chasm

Asymptomatic - someone who does not show any symptoms.



Define it:

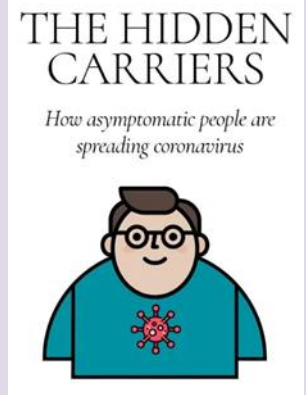
A/An = Meaning **without/lacking of/not**

Abyss - Jackson stared down into the deep **abyss**.

Asymptomatic - Michelle had no idea she had Covid because she was **asymptomatic**.
