Measuring and assessing the impact of the careers programme on pupils

At St Joseph's School we believe it is very important to assess the impact of our careers programme on our pupils. We do this in a number of ways

We identify and analyse the destinations of our Year 11 pupils taking into account and recording their pathways

- BTEC Level 2 Course
- Level 2 Apprenticeships
- BTEC Level 3 courses
- Level 3 apprenticeships
- A level
- T Level

We work closely with local colleges and providers to track where pupils have gone onto either higher education and the course being studied or onto apprenticeship and whether it is intermediate advanced or higher level.

Career guidance consulatation are evaluated with the pupil and action plans are recorded and saved and sent to pupil and parent/carers and under pupil file in careers department

We evaluate the careers provision at St Josephs through pupil/parent/organisation/staff evaluations

We have pupil career champions who meet up regularly with the careers lead and discuss ways for improvement the programme
