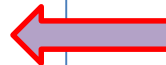

# Definitions

**De-escalate-** reduce the intensity of a conflict or potentially violent situation

**Debug-** identify and remove errors from computer hardware or software or remove insects from somewhere

**Devalue** – reduce or underestimate the worth or importance of something or someone



Define it:

**De** = Meaning **down/of/away**

**De-escalate** - The police are trained to de-escalate situations so that people don't get hurt.

**Debug** - When we moved into our new house it was full of insects so we had to have it debugged.

**Devalue** - Sophie felt devalued when her hard work was not recognised by her teacher.
