Definitions

Excavate- dig out material or make a hole in the ground (*cavare is Latin for hollow*)

Exhale- Breathe out (*halare is Latin for breathe, which is where the 'hale' part of the word comes from*)

Extract – remove or take out, quite often by effort or force



In action:

Ex = Meaning **out of/from/former**

Excavate - In 1982 **excavations** in the centre of Wigan revealed extensive evidence of Roman occupation dating to the 1st and 2nd centuries AD.

Exhale - Lots of people use breathing exercises to help control their emotions. Counting in when they inhale and also when they **exhale**.

Extract - Sam enjoyed **excavating** and showed people the fossils he **extracted** from chalk.
