Definitions

Insert - To place, fit, or push (something) into something else.

Inspection- To careful examination or scrutiny.
Look into something in detail

Infiltrate – To gain access gradually or in secret



In Action:

in = in or into

Insert - Karen hated her last job which was **inserting** advertisement leaflets into newspapers

Inspection - John really enjoyed his job as a building **inspector**.

Infiltrate - Emma loved her new job in the police force. She had to **infiltrate** a drug gang.
